- (ALL HANDS): Colors will be conducted in the appropriate dress uniform of the day (Dress Blue, Dress Whites). Refer to the POD for the proper uniform for colors. If you are a backup on the flag Detail, arrive in your appropriate dress uniform and bring your CUU's. - (Commanding Officer)

- (ALL HANDS): Ben Moreell Battalion will be starting a flag detail. The flag detail will be responsible for raising, lowering and protecting the colors in the morning and afternoon. The raising and lowering of the colors will be conducted in the appropriate dress uniform of the day. This detail is a very important and sacred honor much like the color guard.
